Seven Republicans Voted Along with the Democrats to rejects full Obamacare repeal without replacement The vote was 45- 55

CNN reports that: The <u>Congressional Budget Office estimates the proposal would result in 32 million more uninsured</u> over the next decade. Three-quarters of the nation would live in areas with no insurers participating in the individual market by 2026, CBO said, leaving many without an option if they do not have employer-provided or government health insurance, such as Medicare or Medicaid.
