The INVEST Act passed the House Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure -- including a crew of two on all freight trains. The legislation is expected to have a full vote in the U.S. House on June 30th. Email today and ask your U.S.

Representative to vote YES on H.R. 2, the INVEST Act.

Protect rail safety in our communities, support the INVEST Act (H.R. 2)

The rail provisions in the INVEST Act (H.R. 2) are truly a matter of public and employee safety and security. It is for these reasons that I respectfully ask that you support rail safety in your district and all across America. Specifically, the INVEST Act:

- 1) requires two-person crews on all freight trains, with few exceptions;
- 2) covers Yardmasters under Hours of Service;
- 3) outlines a strategy for Amtrak to move away from being "profit" based to being "service" based;
- 4) adds a study of safety impacts of long trains and Precision Scheduled Railroading;
- 5) requires brakes subject to leaking in the cold be pulled out of service;
- 6) creates additional oversight on failure of PTC systems;
- 7) directs FRA to better include labor in accident investigations;
- 8) deploys a federal standard to reduce blocked grade crossings;
- 9) adds crew size and train length to FRA accident reports;
- 10) and, adds a labor member to the Amtrak Board of Directors.
