Voting by Absentee or Mail-in Ballot in PA

Absentee and mail-in ballot applications for the April 28, 2020, primary election must be received by your <u>county election office</u> by 5 p.m. on Tuesday, April 21, 2020.

What are mail ballots?

In Pennsylvania, you now have two options for mail ballots. You may either choose a mail-in ballot or an absentee ballot to request, complete, and return to your <u>county election office</u>.

• **Absentee ballot** – If you plan to be out of the municipality on election day or if you have a disability or illness, you should request this ballot type, which still requires you to list a reason for your ballot.

• **Mail-in ballot** – If you aren't an absentee voter, you may apply for a mail-in ballot. You may simply request this ballot without a reason.

In order to request either ballot type, you must be registered to vote. Please visit <u>Check Your Registration</u> <u>Status</u> to review your registration information

Option 1: Apply for a Mail-in Ballot Online

Registered voters can apply for a mail-in ballot online with a <u>valid PA driver's license or photo I.D.</u> from the PA Department of Transportation (PennDOT).

Option 2: Apply for a Mail-in Ballot by mail



Step 1: Complete a paper mail-in ballot application:

Download and print a mail-in ballot application:

- Mail-in Ballot Application (English)
- Mail-in Ballot Application (Spanish)

Fill in the paper mail-in ballot application.



Step 2: Mail your application:

Send your mail-in ballot application to the <u>county election office</u>. The deadline to apply for a mail-in ballot is one week before the election.

What is absentee voting?

- The way a person can vote who cannot go to a Polling Place on Election Day for a reason specified in the Delaware Code.
- A person can vote absentee by mail or at the Department's office in their county.

Who can vote by absentee ballot?

A person who:

- Is registered to vote;
- Fills out and signs an Absentee Statement (Application);
- Cannot vote on Election Day because of the reason marked on the application.

What are the deadlines?

Important deadlines for voters

Date	Event
Jan 1, 2020	The Department of Elections can begin to accept Absentee Statements (Applications) for the 2020 Elections.
April 4, 2020	Last day to register to vote before the April 28, 2020 Presidential Primary election.
