The Pa. Supreme Court: The court is adopting the "Carter Plan" for Congressional maps

The Pa. Supreme Court: The court is adopting the "Carter Plan" for Congressional maps, which keeps maps very similar to the ones the court drew in 2018. It is unlikely to create a big shift in the makeup of the congressional delegation, as the state loses a seat, going from 18 to 17, to account for stagnant population growth in census findings over the past decade,

The map provides eight Republican-leaning districts, six Democratic-leaning districts and three closely divided districts, according to an analysis. Pennsylvania's delegation is currently split evenly, nine Republicans and nine Democrats, in a state where registered Democrats outnumber Republicans by 4 million to 3.4 million.
