WHY ARE SOME POLITICIANS TRYING SO HARD TO DESTROY OUR DEMOCRACY?

Arizona bill would allow legislators to overturn the results of a primary or general election



A conservative member of Arizona's state House of Representatives has proposed a mammoth overhaul of the state's voting procedures that would allow legislators to overturn the results of a primary or general election after months of unfounded allegations and partisan audits.

[The bill](#), introduced by state Rep. John Fillmore (R), would substantially change the way Arizonans vote by eliminating most early and absentee voting and requiring

people to vote in their home precincts, rather than at vote centers set up around the state.

Much more troubling, Fillmore's bill would require the legislature to hold a special session after an election to review election processes and results, and to "accept or reject the election results."

Elections law changes to stifle voting and continued jerryandering of districts will inevitably bring labor unions down. Your vote is important and who you vote for makes a difference. Voting for anti-union candidates will inevitably has a devastating effect on your wages and benefits because without your union contract you will have little, or more than likely, no say on wages and benefits. No union=No contract. No contract means you are merely an at-will employee. As an at-will employee, the employer can terminate you at any time for any reason and your wages and benefits will be determined solely by your employer.
