### Bobby Wilson beats Darlene Harris in Pittsburgh City Council primary upset

In an electoral upset that will surely shock City Hall and give Mayor Bill Peduto a cause to celebrate, Spring Hill's Bobby Wilson beat longtime Pittsburgh Councilwoman Darlene Harris in Tuesday's Democratic primary in City Council District 1.

It was Mrs. Harris' rocky relationship with the mayor that Mr. Wilson targeted during the campaign. He frequently said the councilwoman's confrontational approach to governing prevented the North Side from getting the resources it needs to flourish.

"I think that working together is really going to move the North Side forward, and I think a lot of people knew that," Mr. Wilson said Tuesday night at his election party at Elk's Lodge. "A lot of new people who moved in and a lot of older people may have wanted a fresh start."

Bobby's message was that he'd work to ensure the North Side is prosperous for all and has a vision for the future.
